Traditional Learning Model Safety Measures:

- Students will be transported to school via the bus, parents, and/or personal vehicles
- Students, faculty, and staff may wear masks/face coverings on the bus and in the buildings
- Hand sanitizer is provided throughout all buildings and classrooms
- Temperatures will be taken in the classroom when the students arrive. If their temperature is 100 degrees or higher, that student will be moved to another room and their parents notified to come and pick them up.
- If there is a positive case with a student or staff member the school will go to 10 days of distant learning and quarantine. We do not require testing to come back to school.
- Students will be asked to wash hands frequently throughout the day
- Students may be assigned seats in the lunchroom
 - Lunch will be provided like normal with some safety precautions

Distance/Remote Learning Model Rules and Procedures:

- School appropriate dress code still applies
- iPads will be provided by school district for grades 1-3. Laptops will be provided by the school district for grades 4-6
 - Students and parents must sign Acceptable Use Agreement before distribution of iPads and laptops
- Internet accessibility will be the responsibility of the parent/guardian
- Grading policies and procedures will be followed as if the student(s) were in physical attendance
- Grading scales will be the same as if the student(s) were in physical attendance
- Distance learning students can participate in sports; all safety rules and procedures must be followed
- Eligibility will be determined by grades; eligibility report will be dispersed on Wednesday and remain in effect from Wednesday to Tuesday

Visitors including Parents/Guardians/Grandparents etc.:

- Parents/guardians/grandparents should drop off and pick up children outside the building for added health and safety measures

Visitors including Delivery, Facility Maintenance Personnel, etc.:

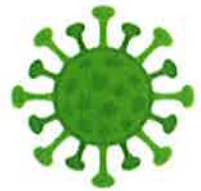
- All visitors entering the building must use hand sanitizer and sign in at the Front Door entry first before going into the building and again when leaving the building.

Additional Protections:

- Wash your hands often; avoid close contact; cover coughs and sneezes; do not share materials
